06. Summary of background:

Community capacity building is one of the main objectives of USS Participatory Action Research (PAR) method. USS gives priority woman and children in the selection of beneficiary. To build up quality social worker who will learn from community learning process and help to build USS as knowledge based organization.

The main activity of this project is to take all initiatives by capacity building of targeting people. In spite of preliminary right holder of this project is women and man, the role of women is more important. The main aspect of this project is to build up gender equal society by enhancing empowerment of communities. To achieve **Promote Gender Equality through Local Knowledge and People's Initiative Project (PGELKPI)**, USS organized and conducted some activities like Base line survey, group meeting, training, workshop, Union parishad meeting and Gender related theater presentation through local knowledge on community basis.

Activities are: (Project inauguration, Staff recruitment, Base line survey, Exposure visit, Group formation & selected group leadership, Meeting , Training, Workshop, Orientation, Theater group formation & presentation, Gathering of Gonogabashona group, Adolescent forum formation, 05 pre-school formed, Essay, art & Debate competition, Karate training.)

- ✚ We have completed project staff recruitment successfully.
- ✚ We have completed base line survey of working area.
- ✚ We have identified right holders.
- ✚ Group members decided that they will arrange workshop/meeting once a week for 2 hours.
- ✚ We have formed 02 groups of drama & 02 folk song groups.
- ✚ We have completed monthly staff meeting for twelve times.
- ✚ We have completed selection 20 Institution (High School and College) of working area.

Main Story:

Aloka Rani's family lives at Mondir para, village- Dubachuri, union- Lachichap, upazila sadar in Nilphamari district. Her husbands' name is Milon Roy. He is a village doctor. They have one daughter and one son. She married in 15 years old. Her father think that all problems will be solved if Aloka got married. When she came to her father in lows house in 15 years old. She had no experience about house hold. As a result not only her father in low and mother in low but also her husband tortured her physically and mentally. Without protest Aloka Rani endures all kinds of torture. This is because Aloka Rani always got pain. Because her husband did not evaluate her. Even she was not permitted to come out from the home and also not permitted to talk to her neighbor.



Milon Roy thought there is no need women to come out from house even talk to others. Milon Roy also think women are only saris which are kept in show case. At that time a Ganogabeshona group is arranged at Mondir para of Dubachari in the name of village "Promote Gender Equality through Local Knowledge & People's Initiative Project" implemented by the Udayankur Seba Sanghta (USS) with the help of Diakonia Bangladesh. Aloka Rani became a member of the group. Though she is member of the Gabeshona group but could not participate in Gabeshona because she was not permitted to come out her husband. Aloka Rani got opportunity to join to the Gabeshona group when her husband did not stay at home. At one stage of the Gabeshona Aloka Rani exposed her all kinds of family problems to the members of the Gabeshona Group. Hearing Aloka Ranis family problems all the members of the Gabeshona group decided that they would Gabeshona all the members and their husbands of the group, because they also

should know what kinds of discussion are done by us. Accordingly one day the Gabeshona on male & female are done. That day the subject of the gabeshona was male and female both are human beings and the work of the woman is work of the man. After Gabeshona on this subjects Milon Roy understood that women have own opinions. He also think a family cannot developed if we do not show respect to their opinion and not allow them to came out from house. Now Aloka Rani Share to her husband about all subject, even some times Milon Roy also come to the Gabeshona group with his wife. Now Milon has no waong idea about women. He is changed by the Gabeshona group of the “Promote Gender Equality through Local Knowledge & People’s Initiative” project. Now Aloka Rani can come out from home without permission of her husband. Even her husband himself does all kinds of home works if Aloka Rani came out from home for work. Aloka Rani says “Promote Gender Equality through Local Knowledge & People’s Initiative” Project implemented by the Udayankur Seba Sanghta (USS) has removed all superstitions of my life and increases my impotency in my family. So that I thanks to the Udayankur Seba Sanghta.

The major outcome, impact, highlights for this year

Results 1: Gender discrimination decreased.

USS Believe & incorporate Gender concept in all of its activities. All of its major activity to bring gender equality among the community, USS involves the total community people with this program. The community people are local government representatives, NGOs and employees, school teachers and student. USS working to build 10 gender model villages to achieve the gender indicators, so that the result is replicated in other adjacent villages in time. To achieve gender equality USS organize and conduct some activity like group Gabeshona, drama presentation, Gender training, workshop, day observation, Ganogabeshona forum meeting , adolescent forum committee meeting, discussion meeting on community basis, dhan bank executive committee meeting, and also family based discussion meeting to establish. For this the flowing impact has occurred in the project area:

- Improvement of women’s participation in family and social decision making process.
- Improvement of women’s ownership in assets.
- Improvement of men’s participation in household works and women’s participation in income generating activities.
- Improvement of men’s participation in family planning process.
- Improvement of women’s participation in cultural activities.

As a result of the saying activity:

- ✚ Women ownership over family properties (Land, Furniture and Ornament) has increased up to 33.55 % which was 31.25% in December 2012.(Increased up to 2.3%)
- ✚ Women's Participation in the family decision making process has increased up to 35% which was 30% in December 2012. (Increased up to 5%)
- ✚ Women participants are taking decision buying and selling of necessary commodities has increased up to 50.87% which was 45% in December 2012.(Increased up to 5.87%)
- ✚ Men's participation in household activities has increased up to 44% which was 35% in December 2012.(Increased up to 9%)
- ✚ Women's participation in cultural activities has increased up to 56.33% which was 40% in December 2012. (Increased up to 16.33%)
- ✚ Incident of women torture has decreased up to 44.17% which was 50% in December 2012. (Decreased up to 5.83%).
- ✚ Women's participation in organizational and committee decision making process 21.89% which was 18.75% in December 2012. (Increased up to 3.14%)
- ✚ Women's and men's participants jointly doing cultural program in the project area has increased up to 52.12% which was 45% in December 2012.(Increased up to 7.12%)

- ✚ The participation in family planning process of men's 17.23% which was 15.62% in December 2012(Increased up to 1.61%)
- ✚ The participation in family planning process husband and wife jointly 8.30% which was 0% in December 2012. (Increased up to 8.30%)
- ✚ Women's participation in social activities has increased 1.61% which was 0% in December 2012. (Increased up to 1.61%)

Main Story:

Anwara Begum (37) And her family live in Nilpamari district under sadar upazila Laxmipur Union at Dubachuri village at Bogra Para. She has two daughters and two sons. There are six members in their family. Her husband Hashem Ali (40) is a day laborer. Her husband manage the entire family with his little income. It is quite impossible for him to arrange two meals in a day. They often starve. Anwara Begum has no land without six decimals for the settlement. She belonged to that land by deed two years ago. Anwara Begum



does not find any way to run her family well. So, she wants to go another people house with her husband for searching work. But women are prohibited to join outside workforce in male dominated society and not allowed to meet with other men. For this her husband does not permit her to go outside. Her husband says that the society will confine them in the house, if she goes out. Anwara Begum cannot say any more to her husband. When her children feel strong hungry, she collects arum leaves and other vegetables. Firstly boiled them vegetables and fed the children and ate herself. Thus, they pass over their days.

In above circumstances, Anowar Begum became a member of community Dhan Bank with the help of Udayankar Seba Sangstha (USS). She became an executive member of this Dhan bank. At times, she goes to meeting. But her husband and other peoples in the society hinder her way of life. Yet, nobody stops her. She takes Dhan from Dhan Bank at time of Monga and after Monga she returns Dhan. As results, her wants solved something. She does not pay much profit in Dhan Bank. Besides different IGA training held in

Dhan Bank. She took part in all training like vegetable cultivation tamed of duck, hen etc. After receiving training, she took loan from Dhan Bank and bought some hens and started tame. She also cultivated vegetables in her yard. She paid bank loan by selling hens and bought a goat. Now her family is well-off. At that time, Promote Gender Equality through Local Knowledge & People's Initiative project started under Udayankar Seba Sangstha (USS). Men and women Ganogabeshona group consist of under this project in Bogura Para. Anowara Begum is a chairperson of that group. Dhan Bank as well as Promote Gender Equality through Local Knowledge & People's Initiative project helped her to materialize dream. Anowara Begum said that I would spend whole life through sufferings, if I did not go out. She organizes men and women both together in her area through Ganogabeshona group and Promote Gender Equality through Local Knowledge & People's Initiative project. She completed eight marriage functions without dowry with the help of this project and took advance Den Mohar at this time of marriage. She completed pace about fifteen tube-wells among fifteen families, setup two tube-wells and setup seventeen sanitary latrine in her area communicating with RDRS Bangladesh. Everybody in the society does not think a day without Anowara Begum. Now, they face any problem, they try to solve their own effort. If they unable to solve the problem, then they call Anowara Begum for dissolve the problem. Anowara Begum has already stopped quarrelling among the twenty three families. The Ward Member Mr. Bodiuzzaman called Anowara before solving any problem. Anowara Begum took some govt. facilities in her area by communicating with Union Parishad . Now, the villagers respect Anowara very hardly. Anowara says that now their family is running perfectly and they took three meals in a day. My daughter is studying. My personal efficiency has been increase through these activities. Anowara Begum said that proud of it was quite impossible to earn this honor without the assistance of Udayankur Seba Sangstha. I hope that if each woman come forward in this regard, it will be possible to remove discrimination between men and women. And will be developed in a family, in a society and in a country.

Results 2 : Leadership capability increased.

USS has organized new female & male groups with nursing all targeted groups and arranged social leadership development program such as Leadership training, Day observation, Group Gabeshona, Gathering with ganogabeshon group, Gender training, Training on domestic law, drama presentation, workshop with union standing committee, democratic rights , necessity of local election, necessity of participation etc. For this the flowing impact has occurred in the project area:

- Increased the condition of human rights in family level (Early marriage, dowry, multiple marriages).
- Increased the women's leadership.
- Increased the women's participation decision making process.
- Increased the women's movement of freedom.

As a result of the saying activity:

- ✚ Women's leader are playing role in local level salish has increased up to 23.77% which was 20% in December 2012.(Increased up to 3.77%)
- ✚ Women's participants raised their torture and opposing objection openly has increased up to 35.87% which was 31.25% in December 2012. (Increased up to 4.62%)
- ✚ Women's participation in cultural activities has increased up 47.15% to which was 40% in December 2012.(Increased up to 7.15%)
- ✚ Early marriage has decreased up to 11.45% which was 13.75% in December 2012. (Decreased up to 2.3%)
- ✚ Marriages has completed without any dowry has increased up to 15 which was 10 in December 2012.(Increased up to 5)
- ✚ Women's participation in various local level decision making committee (SMC, Tree plantation committee, Nari O Shishu Narjaton Potiroth committee, Word committee, PRDP-2) has increased up to 18.87% which was 12.50% in December 2012.(Increased up to 6.37%)
- ✚ Movement of Women freedom has increased up to 32.59% which was 0% in December 2012. (Increased up to 32.59%)
- ✚ Communication between women and Govt /private NGO has increased up to 25.98% which was 0% in December 2012. (Increased up to 25.98%)
- ✚ Women's participation in social activities has increased 1.61% which was 0% in December 2012.(Increased up to 1.61%)

- ✚ Women's participation in the seminar, meeting has increased 35.47% which was 0% in December 2012. (Increased up to 34.47%)
- ✚ Women can speak in the meeting at 16.81% which was 0% in December 2012. (Increased up to 16.81%)

Main Story :

Kawshola Rani and her family live in Nilphamari district at dubachuri village Luxmichap union under sadar Upazila. Kawshola Rani is 35 years old and her husband is Madhushadan Roy is 40 years old. They have four sons. Her family was depended on her husband income. It is quite impossible to maintain such this big family with her husbands low income. At that moment USS made a Ganogabeshona group under 'Promote Gender Equality through Local Knowledge & People's Initiative' project at Dubachuri Sharkar para village. Kawshola became a member of this group and the Gabeshona regularly on both men and women activities.. Kawshola realized her own condition through Gabeshona. She discussed with her husband about this family affair and found reason for poverty.

Now , Kawshola does not want to stay at home anymore. She also wants to earn some money. For this reason she counsels with her husband how to raise income. As a result Madhushadan Roy became very pleased with her wife's attitudes. He said that we would have found out a planned certainly. After some days, Kawshola Rani and her husband brought one ram calves on condition from a rich man for tame. Later they sold rams and bought a cow calf by 8000/- (Eight thousand) taka. After 10 months they sold the cow by 16000/- (Sixteen thousand) taka in December. In the mean time, they bought two cow by 14000/- and they took a plan for cultivating by the rest of money. Kawshola Rani has commented that her husbands no pay heed her opinion in the past. Now he evaluates me for incoming power and shares me about family affairs. At present, we do all tasks by careful plan. I assist my husbands in income to lead the family. Thus our family has become fulfilled in peace.

Results 3: Income increased.

USS targets population will achieve economic development. All the members of the family will join in planning in the family affairs and consequence in the annual income increasing. To increasing income by gender equity, USS organized group

meeting and motivation IGA issue. For this the flowing impact has occurred in the project area:

- Increased female income.
- Increased various occupations.
- Improvement of right holder's social status.

As a result of the saying activity:

- ✚ Female member's income has increased up to 22.81% which was 9.87% in December 2012. (Increased 12.94%)
- ✚ Right holders involved in various occupations (Agriculture, handy craft, carchupi has increased up to 28.06% which was 19.71% in December 2012. (Increased up to 8.35%)
- ✚ Right holder's social status change has increased up to 16.20% which was 13.14% in December 2012.(Increased up to 3.06%)

Main Story:

It happened on 11th August 2013 at Khalisha Phacha village, Polashbari union, in the Nilphamari sadar upazila in Nilphamari district.

Rupali's father is Subash Roy and mother is Krisna Rani Roy . Rupali has two sisters and one brother. Rupali read in class ten in faruk school, chocua. All of a sudden some people, along with Rupali's would be bridegroom went to Rupali's house and discussed dowry for Rupali's marriage. Rupali's education was brought to a sudden halt.

Rupali was heartbroken at this sudden turn of events. She had dreamt of completing her study and be self employed and would enjoy women's empowerment. She started to think about ways to stop her early marriage.

She remembered the Khalisha Pacha Kishori Gono Gobeshana group. She went to see Joyanti Rani, president of the Gono



Gobeshana group. She shared her plight with the president. The president Joyanti Rani discussed with her group members as to how to help Rupali. After discussion they went to Rupali's Father and raised the point that she was under 18 and was still a child. Rupali's marriage at this early age would affect her physically and mentally and her family would face lot of problems.

Through group discussion the members decided to take recourse to any method that would stop Rupali's early marriage. They again went to Rupali's father. Her father said that Rupali will not have any more education, particularly when the social condition is so bad. He has found a good bride groom for Rupali and a good family. So he could not miss the opportunity for Rupali's marriage. The group tried to tell him from Rupali's perspective. She was still a little child and is now crying at the prospect of her separation from her parents. They also told him about the plight of those who were given to early marriage. Every child has right to education. Why would he deprive her of her right? Early marriage would not free the parents from their duties to their child. Parents should educate their children and bring them up so that they are independent and be healthy. Otherwise the parents would suffer their whole life. The group members suggested that the father should use the money for money for some better purposes, and should give Rupali to marriage when she completes her education and when she is adult. Finally the team requested her father to send Rupali to school and let her continue her education. Rupali's father did not reply and kept silent.

After a few days Rupali started to go to the School regularly, but the whole matter did not rest there. Rupali one day informed the team that her father was going to give the dowry after all. The members of the Khalisha Pacha Kishori Gono Gobeshana group again went to see her father, this time with all the respectable persons of the village to persuade her father to stop this child marriage. They had to put pressure on her father by telling him that he might have to face punishment for child marriage if he agreed to child marriage.

At the end Rupali's father agreed to give up child marriage on condition that Rupali must do well in her studies. Otherwise he will give her to marriage. The group members were very happy at this outcome. They told the father not only to look after her studies but also to take good care of the family and to consult the family members before taking any decision.

At last the father decided to refuse the offer of Rupali's marriage after consulting with his wife. Consequently Rupali can now go the School. She is very happy now. She thanked all the members of the Khalisha Pacha Kishohri Gono Gobesona group for saving her from certain death.

The whole team of the Khalisha Pacha Kishohri Gono Gobesona group was very happy and they thanked the USS. They could not do it if the USS did not sponsor for Gabeshona that had helped them stop this early marriage. Now all the members have taken oath and speak loudly: "Let's not allow any child marriage to happen in this village".



Results 4: Quality education promotes.

Promoting Quality education for gender equality, USS executes 05 preschool and conduct meeting with pre- school parents, Child Gathering, and preschool teacher's refreshers. For this the flowing impact has occurred in the project area:

- Decreased of droop out students.
- Improvement of pre education with quality.

As a result of the saying activity:

- ✚ Drooped out students are going school has increased up to 26.02% which was 25% in December 2012. (Increased up to 1.02)
- ✚ Promoted about quality of pre education has increased up to 400 students which were 150 students in December 2012. (Increased up to 250 students)
- ✚ Promoted cultural program (Rhyme, Song & Dance) has increased up to 84.25% student which was 50% students in December 2012. (Increased up to 34.25%)

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Main Story:

Maya Rani Roy lives at Vabankuri village of Polashbari Union with her husband Shanimol Roy and two sons. She got married when she was only nine years old. Maya Rani had been lived six years in a joint family where her father-mother in laws, sister in laws and brother in laws lived together. After five years Maya Rani is separated from the family. After separation she had no crops land except the land of house. Her husband though man would earn money and woman would do only house hold works. At this time 20 groups are formed in the name of "Promote Gender Equality through Local Knowledge & Peoples Initiative" project sponsor by the Udayankur Seba Sangstha(USS) under the Co-operation at diakonia of them Female groups-10, Male groups-04, Kishari groups- 04 and Kishor groups-02. Ganogabeshona forum committee are formed consists of 14 members who comes from the above mentioned group. The meeting of the Ganogabeshona forum held after every three months. Many kinds of problems are detected in the forum meeting. When the member of the forum starts Gabeshona on various problems they realized that it is very essential to build up good relations with Union Parishad. Then members of the forum communicated with the union Parishad and wanted to know how many kinds of services are available and who are deserve to get this service. Maya Rani Member of the forum came to know that requisition of VGD card has come to Union Parishad. The members of the forum called a meeting on basis of this news. According to the resolution of the Union Parishad and knew details about the VGD card due to short time the members of the forum asked Maya Rani to submit her photograph and identity card. According to this advice Maya Rani submitted her photograph and identity card on 2th December in 2012 to the concerned authority. Thus Ganogabeshona forum helps Maya Rani to get the Govt. service VGD card. For this card Maya Rani received 60 kgs.Rice for two months on 28.02.2013. Maya Rani told that Gabeshona helped her to make

self sufficient. Her husband Shonimal Roy also told the house hold becomes happy if man and woman work together and it are possible to get more benefit if there is unity between husband and wife.

Results 5: Duty bearer more responsible.

For increasing duty bearer more responsible USS organized group meeting, gathering, training, community dhan bank executive committee meeting, workshop with up level, up standing committee level. For this the flowing impact has occurred in the project area:

As a result of the saying activity:

- ✚ Right holder have gotten health facilities form near community clinic like as medicine and treatment has increased up to 55.84% which was 42.70% in December 2012. (Increased up to 13.14%)
- ✚ Wages of women and men workers increased up to 13.65% which was 10.50% in December 2012. (Increased up to 3.15%)
- ✚ Right holder have taken family planning facilities has increased 16.81% which was 0% in December 2012. (Increased up to 16.81%)
- ✚ Union Parishad help service increased 6.88% in almost Right Holder which was 0% in December 2012. (Increased up to 6.88%)
- ✚ 21.02% Right Holder gotten forestry department help service which was 0% in December 2012. (Increased up to 21.02%)

Results 6: Staff and management capacity building

USS has implement particular programs in its working area like monthly staff meeting, planning meeting among executive members and staffs ,meeting of USS executive committee , meeting of USS General committee ,exposure visit and staff development training to established following activities:

As a result of the saying activity:

- ✚ All staffs can identified own and project activity, organizational strong and weak side and also take necessary steps as needed.
- ✚ Staffs can formulate future working plan and can execute working methodology as per planning.

9. Problem:

1. It has taken some time to release fund from NGO affairs bureau.
2. Most of men go to out of our project area at various seasons for earning. So group members look after family work (cultivation, plantation, domestic animal rearing). As a result some time group member presence in presence decrease in the meeting.
3. Sometimes group meeting has been hampered rainfall, cold wave.
4. Our some activities hampered for National political crises.

10. Challenges:

- Our main challenge was staffs qualities build up in this year.

11. Lesson learned:

- ✚ Social acceptance of project activity has been increased through various participation of teachers, land owners, Union Parishad and other local elite people along with deprived people.
- ✚ Through Drama and Song, message of program gets rapid publicity and people awareness is increased.
- ✚ The more the aim and objective of project, implementation process, expecting result are clear to the workers of all level of project, the more the result will be better. It is essential for growing skilled worker.
- ✚ Giving necessary cooperation at field level from USS management committee is very essential for good project performance.
- ✚ If women take part in buying and selling commodities in market they will be skilled in taking decisions.
- ✚ If we start discussion by saying 'male female equality' then losses its acceptance to male. The fact of male female equality becomes acceptable to all when the discussion continues on the basis of analyzing the practical problems.
- ✚ Works don't belong to gender but when men take part in house hold works most of men think that they are doing female's work.
- ✚ Right holders don't have sufficient information about govt & non-govt service.
- ✚ Work is needed to active standing committees of union parishod.
- ✚ UP help's occurring early marriage by increasing age couple.
- ✚ The knowledge, experience of aged people is being neglected in the society. Activities should be done to utilize this knowledge and experience

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
