Human chain held with the joint initiatives of young people and Reflection Action circle members. Where Upazila Nirbahi Officer was present as chief guest. The Reflection Action Circle members participates National Disaster Preparedness Day with Upazila Disaster Management committee and Fire Service and Civil Defence. The Reflection Action Circle members also participate on Mock drill session on fire. One billion rising program held with the presence of Young people, Women leaders and Stop Violence against women committee members. Where Upazila Nirbahi Officer was the chief guest. Our project participants claim their rights in the relevant government departments and local government institutions and got support from that department. Our Sponsor children participated in upazila level competition for explored their potentiality and got prize from Upazila Nirbahi Officer. On the other hand total expenditure rate is 88% in this quarter.

Those who have been successful from the Community level. all the members present told the objective success stories. Community members were inspired by the success stories. On the occasion of International Women's Day, Phulbari Adarsho High School first organized an essay competition on the topic "Investment and Success in Women" in the light of International Women's Day at 11:30 with the permission of the Headmaster. A total of nine students of eighth, ninth and tenth classes participated in the essay competition. Md. Morshed Alam, Head Teacher, Phulbari adarsho High School discussed the history of the day and deliver inspirational speech. Inspirator, ActionAid Bangladesh, Sweet Khan gave a talk about Women's Day and what to do to prevent violence against women today and gave an inspirational speech to the students. Youth Hub General Secretary Shakila Akhter (Santa) gave a brief speech on the theme of International Women's Day. Dr. Ferdausi Khatun (Medical Officer) Upazila Family Planning Officer said that, my mother has worked hard behind my success for her future success. A mother can make her child successful by teaching education from childhood. He also said, "We don't live in Paragon today, we are very strong from our place, why we can't , we can do everything if we want, everything is possible if the will and morale are strong." When a woman is successful, her family and society are also successful, that's why women need to be supported without depriving them, listening to women's success stories.
